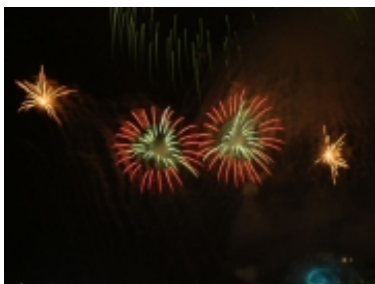

Maltese fireworks club wins Caput Lucis Festival

The Imqabba Fireworks Club of Santa Marija recently took part in an annual international festival in Caput Lucis, Rome Italy.



The five-day long festival also showcased the works of Japanese, Italian, British, Romanian, Slovenian, Spanish and Chinese fireworks. The Maltese club participated on the night of Thursday 2nd August, to crowds made up of around 300,000 persons.

Malta's show was chosen as the best by a panel of eight jurors, who are all fire works experts.

The festival was held in a 80,000 square metre zone in Valmontone, and was sponsored by the region of Lazio and the province of Rome.

The Imqabba Fireworks Club of Santa Marija had also placed first in the International Fireworks Competition held in Malta.

The club will also be holding shows in Malta during the locality's Santa Marija feast between the 14th and 15th August.
