Fireworks in Mqabba for the Santa Marija feast will be let off from a 30-metre high structure synchronised to the sound of music.

To mark the 175th anniversary of the village's Santa Marija statue, fireworks will tonight be let off from above thanks to a top computerised system used worldwide. The display will start at 9.30 p.m. The Mqabba Santa Marija pyrotechnics club had won the International Fireworks Championships in Malta in 2006 and the World Fireworks Championships in Rome in 2007, among other accolades.
